The County of Union will conduct a deer management program in seven parks to prevent the destruction of native park vegetation, minimize damage to residential landscaping, and reduce deer-related motor vehicle accidents. This is not a sport hunt.

Carefully selected hunters with a proficiency in marksmanship, sitting in elevated tree stands, will use shotguns to remove deer from various areas of each park. Hunting will occur during daylight hours only. Any evidence of hunting being conducted on other dates or after dark should be reported immediately to the Union County Police at **908-654-9800**.

This program will operate one day per week from January 4 to February 12. Hunting will generally occur on Mondays; if inclement weather or a holiday precludes hunting on a Monday, the program will be rescheduled for that week to Wednesday or Friday.

These parks will not be closed during hunting. Park users should stay on the trails. Pets should be restrained on a leash. Some venison generated by this program will be distributed to the needy and homeless through the Community FoodBank of NJ.
