

Clark Township Marriage License

Application Requirements

In order to apply for a marriage license in the Township of Clark, the following is required:

1. At least one of the applicants must reside in Clark.
2. Three people, the bride, the groom, or two civil union partners and one witness must appear during the application process. If anyone needs eyeglasses to read, please bring them the day of the application process.
3. The witness must be 18 years of age or older **and** know both parties.
4. All parties must be able to communicate in a language understandable by the Licensing Officer. It is the responsibility of the applicants to have a certified translator if necessary. The translator cannot be a family member.
5. **The Clark Township Registrar requires the following: valid (not expired) government issued photo driver's license or photo non-driver's license. The address on the driver's license must match the address on the application. If the applicant(s) do not possess a valid photo driver's license or photo non-driver's license, then a valid government issued passport or government id containing the name and a picture of the applicant must be submitted along with proof of residency (ex. W-2, bank statement, lease agreement, property deed). U.S. Consular IDs are not acceptable nor are international driver's licenses. In addition, if either party has been divorced, is a widow or widower, or has had a marriage/civil union annulled, divorce papers, church annulment decrees and/or certified death certificates should be presented. The Licensing Officer may request any document(s) that he/she feels is necessary to insure there are no impediments to the marriage/civil union.**
6. A check or money order payable to the Township of Clark in the amount of \$28.00 is required the day of the application. You may bring cash, but it must be exact change.
7. Our appointment times are Monday - Friday 8:30 - 9:30 am **OR** 2:30 - 3:30 pm **ONLY**.
8. **Once a marriage license is applied for, a 72-hour waiting period is required before the marriage license can be picked up. Once picked up, the marriage license is valid for 30 days.**
