SAFETY TIPS FOR ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS



BEFORE THE STORM

- Sign up for local Nixle Alerts from Clark PD at nixle.com
- Sign up for Township News Flashes www.ourclark.com/notifyme
- Clear drains and gutters to help water flow away from your home.
- Check sump pumps and backup power sources (battery or generator).
- Move valuables, important documents and self to higher levels in home during flooding threats.
- Secure outdoor furniture and equipment — anchor or bring them indoors.
- Charge all devices and portable power banks
- Take photos of your property for insurance purposes
- Review your emergency plan with family
- Stock up on essentials:
 - Drinking Water (1gal p. person p. day for 3 days)
 - Non-Perishable foods
 - Flashlights, batteries and portable radio
 - First aid kit and necessary medications

POWER & UTILITIES

- Know how to safely turn off gas, water, electricity in your home
- Unplug electronics to prevent damage from power surges
- Sign Up for email/text messages with all utility companies

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Stay off roads during and after storms unless instructed to evacuate
- Sometimes it is safest to stay where you are instead of trying to get home on dangerous roads
- NO driving through flooded roads
- Barricaded & coned-off streets are closed to everyone, even if you live on the street
- Look for flood warning signs that demonstrate how deep waters are in an area before entering
- Know evacuation routes if instructed to leave
- Stay clear of downed wires

VEHICLE PREP

- Top off your gas tanks in case of power outages or evacuation
- Move vehicles to higher ground if flooding is likely
- Move vehicles off streets in snow storms for plowing
- Pack an emergency car kit
 - Water
 - Snacks
 - Blanket
 - Flashlight
 - Phone Charger

PETS

- Bring Pets indoors before rain or severe weather begins
- Prepare pet food, medications, carries, leashes and ID tags ready in case of evacuation
